A must stop during our food tours, this indoor market is still a place for shopping but also great to spend aperitivo time and. why not, a dinner. At Banco32 you can eat fresh fish with

a daily menu: I went there with Rick Stein and he loved it! In the two squares you can sit and drink a glass of local wine at Altro? or try the flavors of southern Italy at Vini e Sapuri.

VIA GALLIERA

The best way to arrive to Piazza Maggiore from Stazione Centrale (railway station) is taking this street loved by Leonardo Da Vinci. During the way stop at Galliera49 to enjoy my favourite granita of Bologna, and in front of it, at Forno Brisa for a bite of pizza: your lunch is made. A few more meters to meet Azienda Agricola Palladino, a farmers' shop to buy seasonal fruits and vegetables. Take a stop at Piazza della Pioggia where you find Drogheria della Pioggia, a beautiful grocery store with a wide selection of spices, coffee and leave teas.



This street near university area offers everything to spend a great night. At dinner, fans of jazz can find live music and good tortellini at Cantina Bentivoglio and at Da Francesco the fish is prepared with Sicilian recipes. For a craft beer among the students L'Ortica and Modo Infoshop. with a nice library. are the places to go.

After dinner take a beer or a bitter at Barazzo or L'Impiccato and enjoy bolognese movida!

VIA BROCCAINDOSSO

This tiny and coloured street hosts some of my favourite places in town. Osteria Broccaindosso is a must for classic bolognese: try passatelli with porcini mushrooms and their famous dessert trolley. For a different cuisine, at **Scaccomatto** chef Mario Ferrara prepares one of the best fish dishes of Bologna with influences from around the world. Craft beer lovers? Birra Cerqua is the first brew-pub of the city where you can taste amazing beers produced with local ingredients.
